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



What does Local Government Do? (1)



- •Local democratic framework
- Local representational role and underpins local identity
- Direct public services to residents, visitors and investors within a local context
- Delivers on an agency basis for the State, national services more appropriately delivered at a local level
- Facilitates public and private investment




What does Local Government Do? (2)



- Provides the spatial planning context
- Provides the local platform through which social and cultural diversity is facilitated and nurtured
- •Regulates in instances economic and environmental issues as well as providing local consumer protection
- •Facilitates, on behalf of the State, the co-ordination of local, rural and community development



What local government does...key principles of reform



Local Government Reform Act, 2014



- Basic Law for local government in Ireland
- •Refers throughout to "the Principal Act" otherwise known as the Local Government Act 2001
- •Replaces/substitutes/Amends the provisions of the Local Government Acts 1925-2013
- Provides for
- -Local Government Areas
- -Municipal Districts
- -LCDC
- -Economic SPC
- -Regional Assemblies
- -Area Committees
- -National Oversight and Audit Commission
- -Chief Executive Officer
- -National Regulatory Framework



New Governance Code



- Being Developed
- •6 Core Principles and supporting principles
- -Focusing on the purpose of the authority and on outcomes for the community and creating and implementing a vision for the local area
- -Members and officers working together to achieve a common purpose with clearly defined functions and roles
- -Promoting values for the authority and demonstrating the values of good governance through upholding high standards of conduct and behaviour
- -Taking informed and transparent decisions which are subject to effective scrutiny and managing risk
- -Developing the capacity and capability of members and officers to be effective
- -Engaging with local people and other stakeholders to ensure robust public accountability

New economic responsibilities



- Local Enterprise Offices

- Integration of spatial planning and economic development
- Co-ordination with State development agencies
- Regional Economic Overview
- Systemisation of local government policies/services
- Local platform for all local economic development actions by the State
- Crucially
- Continuation of support for micro-enterprise development
- Local vehicle for implementation of the Jobs Action Programme



Municipal Districts Parts 3 – 5 2014 Act



- Outside Dublin Local Authorities divided into Municipal Districts (MD)
- MD is not a separate LA but a statutory (S22 A and S22 B) decision-making body that is a local manifestation of the Local Authority
- A platform for localised decision-making
- Schedule 3, Part 1 Sets out specific reserved functions and responsibilities for MDs
- Part 2 of Schedule 3 sets out reserved functions to be undertaken by either an MD or the Local Authority
- Part 3 Reserved functions of the Local Authority

Municipal Districts Sample Reserved Functions



- Adoption of statements on economic development, community development for the Local Economic and Community Plan
- Consideration of draft budgetary plan
- Consideration of /adoption of the annual schedule of proposed works
- Adoption of scheme for community initiative annual contribution
- Making local by-laws



Future Developments



- Migration of responsibilities for economic development/local, rural and community development
- Development of community participation models
- Criteria for migration of other regional and national services clearly set down
- Need to develop training and education services for councillors
- Build councillors role as local democratic leaders
- Build policy role of AILG
- Development of relationship with CCMA and others to establish local government voice at national policy table
