




National Water Resources Plan & Water Future Forecast





Scale of investment need – Waste Water






Unconstrained Forecast of needs based on current understanding of asset base condition and performance (> €50bn out to 2060s)

> Prioritisation of long list to short list based on Risk and Value approach as part of asset investment planning process.

Constrained Forecast shows spend increasing to between €1.5 to €2bn per annum into 2030s and levelling out at €1.6bn beyond that.



Urban Waste Water – Progress achieved to date




- €1.7bn invested in wastewater assets since 2014
- Approx. 137 upgrade projects included in RBMP (2018-2021) completed
- Full compliance with UWWTD treatment standards by RC4
- Steady progress in getting to full waste water licence standards
- Reduction in Significant

 from 291 down to 208 water bodies



Small Towns and Villages Growth Programme

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
Revenue Control 3 allocated €100M of approved funding towards STVGP. There are currently 37 projects announced for upgrade works across all Local Authority areas.



Revenue Control 4 & 5 are expected to continue or enhance this level of investment in the rural areas through the STVGP.

Timeline for a Project Delivery post analysis and identification of issues





These Guidelines are intended to provide best practice guidance in relation to the interface between the planning authorities and the delivery of public water services by Irish Water.

The Guidelines highlight that 'Irish Water is a statutory consultee under the P&D Act 2000 (as amended) and planning authorities are required to take into account the views of Irish Water in making decisions on statutory plans..'

County Development Plan Process

- Water Supply Capacity Registers represent the top 3 tiers of settlements or 48 settlements as identified in the NPF and RSES.
