Cllr. Nicholas Crossan President AILG 2021/22

Donegal County Councillor Nicholas Crossan became the first Independent elected member to hold the position of AILG President when he was elected

President of the Association of Irish Local Government (AILG) at the AGM on 30 September 2021. The Buncrana native, who is also a past president of the Association of Municipal Authorities of Ireland (AMAI) represents the Municipal District of Inishowen.



**Peter Burke TD** *Minister for Local Government and Planning* 

Peter Burke was appointed Minister of State for Local Government and Planning in July 2020. He hails from Mullingar and

was elected to the Dáil in 2016, having being involved in electoral politics since 2009 when he was first elected to Westmeath County Council. Before being appointed to the Department of Housing, he sat on the Oireachtas Finance and Public Accounts Committees & was a frequent media commentator on tax and financial issues.

Since his appointment, he has worked on projects including the implementation of the Moorhead report, legislation for a democratically elected Mayor for Limerick, maternity leave for female Councillors, updating of the SEA guidelines, the County Development Plan guidelines, rural housing guidelines and planning legislation involving Judicial Review, the Maritime Area Planning Act and the Attorney General's planning review.



**Ciaran Mullooly** Former RTE Broadcaster and

Social Enterprise Officer

A former journalist & correspondent with RTE News, Ciaran Mullooly is a Community Development & Social

Enterprise Worker with Roscommon LEADER partnership. He is the founder of the award-winning Lough Ree Access For All social enterprise project – providing access to the waterways of the midlands for people with disability and mobility issues on a specially designed boat from Ballyleague, county Roscommon.



**Eunan Quinn** Senior Planner, Donegal Co.Co

Eunan Quinn is senior planner at Donegal County Council having graduated from Queen's University

Belfast's School of the Built Environment in 1990. Eunan is an active member of the Irish Planning Institute, having previously served on its national executive, and has a MSC in Innovation Management in the Public Service (jointly conferred by Ulster University & Letterkenny Institute of Technology).

Anne Marie Conlon is the Head of Economic Development and has worked in local government since

2006 in Donegal County Council. Ms. Conlon spent a number of years working with the Donegal County Development Board in the area of Economic, Tourism and Community development.
