



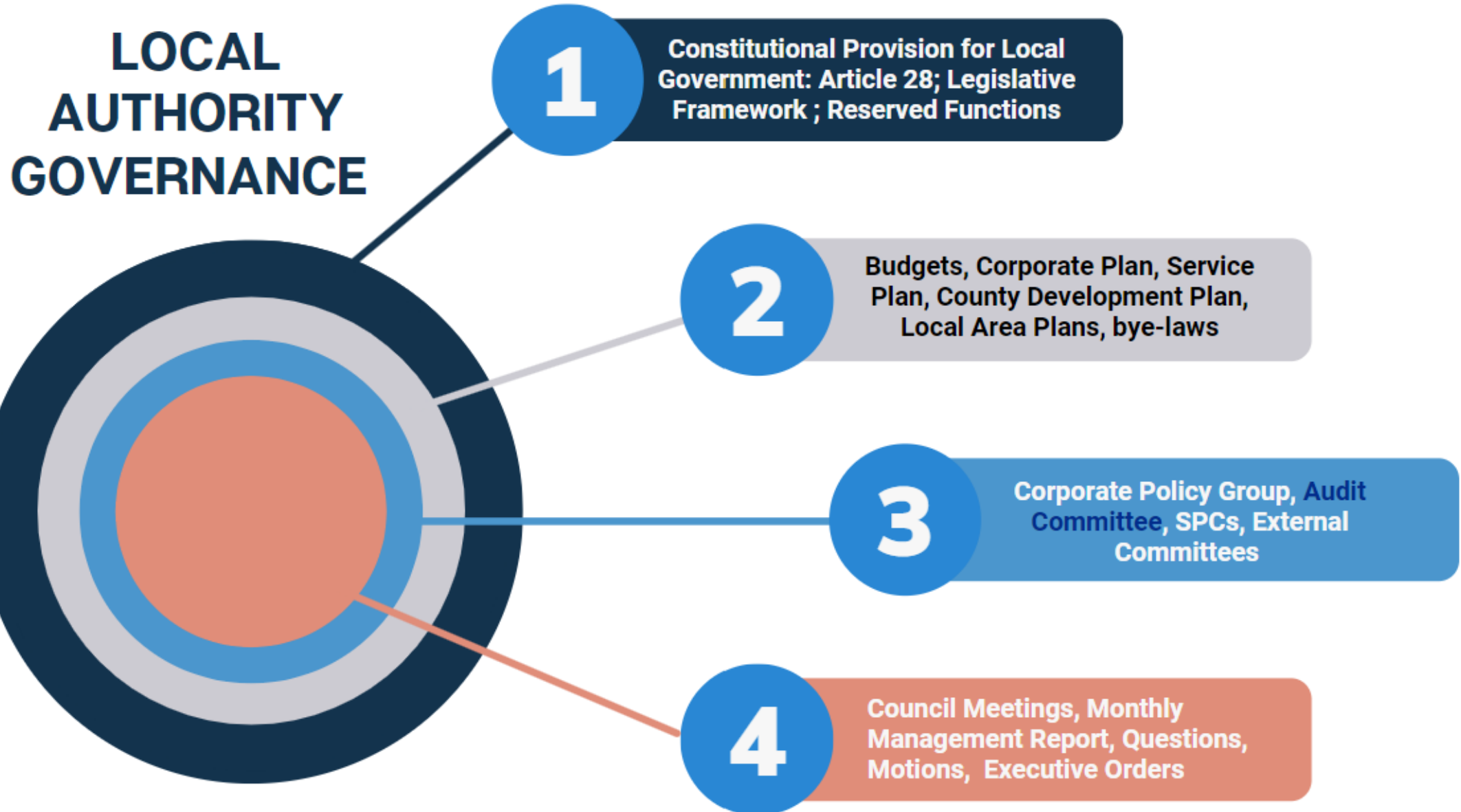

Audit Committee: A key strand of Local Authority Governance

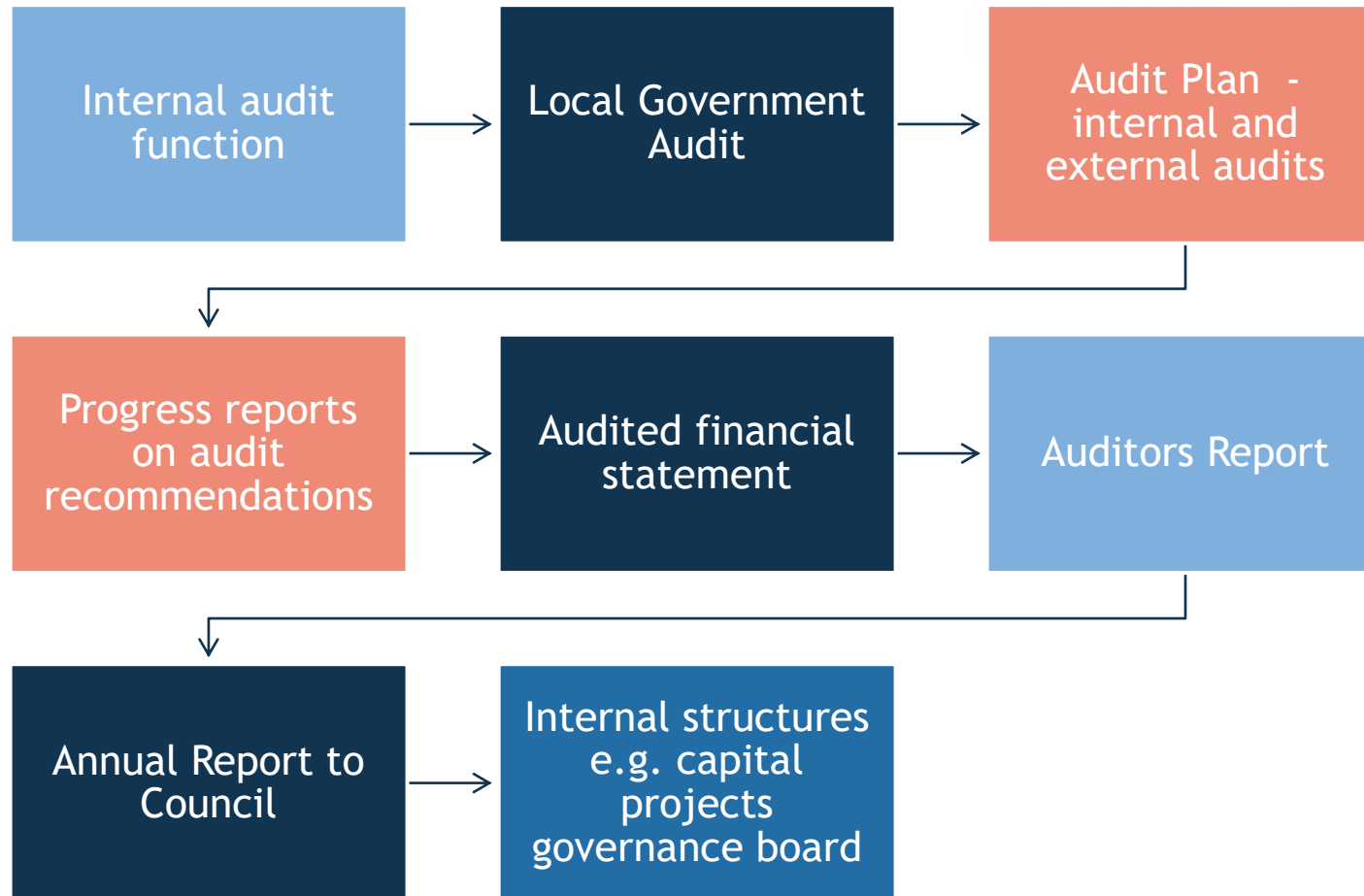


The Audit Committee:



- Membership: 3 Independent members,
3 elected councillors, independent Chair
- Meeting: 6 meetings per year
- Typical meeting length: 3/4 hours

- Risk Register
- Audit Plan reflecting risk register
- Audit Reports
- Progress on Audit Plan and Recommendations (multi-year)
- Report of the Local Government Auditor

- ✓ Independence and objectivity
- ✓ Confidentiality
- ✓ Thoroughness
- ✓ Good practice focus
- ✓ Partnership



A Pro-active Role



- Fostering best practices in performance of internal audit
- Promoting efficiency and value for money
- Reviewing risk management system
- Reviewing audited financial statement, auditor's report
- Assess actions taken by the Chief Executive in response to an audit report
- Overseeing implementation of audit recommendations
